ORDER TERMINATING
SUPERVISION

On April 13, 2026, the Director, Department of Consumer and Business Services, Division of Financial Regulation (the “Director”), pursuant to ORS 750.055(1)(b) and (1)(e), ORS 731.385, ORS 734.043(2), and OAR 836-013-0110, issued an Order of Supervision (the “Order”) immediately placing ATRIO Health Plans, Inc. (the “Company”), an Oregon corporation and Oregon-domiciled health care service contractor (NAIC Company Code 10123), under supervision. On June 8, 2026, the Director, pursuant to ORS 734.047(2), issued an Order Supplementing Order of Supervision (the “Supplemental Order”) extending the period of supervision under the Order for a period ending on the earlier of (i) a determination by the Director that the Company had no unpaid claims over 60 days outside the ordinary course of business and had otherwise continued its progress toward resolving the remaining conditions giving rise to the supervision, and (ii) 60 calendar days from the date of the Supplemental Order.

The Director has determined that the conditions giving rise to the supervision, as described in the Order and the Supplemental Order, no longer exist. Accordingly, pursuant to ORS 734.043, ORS 734.047, and the terms of the Order and the Supplemental Order, the supervision of the Company is terminated as of the date of this order.
